During June, Court Community Service...

- Received **749 community service referrals** from area courts.
- Referrals worked **16,907 hours** of community service resulting in **a savings of \$137,792** to our community.
- **157** area not-for-profit and governmental agencies benefited from Court Community Service programs.
- Received **23 Carrying Concealed Weapon Program referrals** from area courts.

During June, Court Community Service supervised work crews...

- Collected **5,000 bags of litter, 1,041 tires, and 1,223 cubic yards of debris** from public roadways and properties in **53 communities** throughout Cuyahoga County.
- Completed 4 property cleanups in conjunction with the Cleveland Housing Court
- Continued lawn mowing for hundreds of seniors referred by the City of Cleveland's Dept. of Aging. (see below)



Our partnership with the City of Cleveland Dept. of Aging provides senior homeowners with assistance including lawn mowing, leaf raking, and snow shoveling. Last year alone, CCS crews logged more than 12,000 hours helping low-income and disabled seniors in Cleveland – another example of how community service is a “win-win” for the court and our community.
