At our Annual Luncheon on September 29th we honored the Cleveland Housing Court as the recipient of the 2017 Ronald B. Adrine Award. Our close partnership with the Housing Court provides a much needed resource to tackle problem properties in Cleveland neighborhoods. CCS crews help with yard cleanup, landscaping and removing graffiti. The Housing Court also utilizes community service as a sentencing option for indigent offenders and as a condition of community control (probation). It's a "win-win" alternative for the Housing Court and Cleveland neighborhoods!
