- Referrals worked **6,826 hours** of community service resulting in **a savings of \$60,069** to our community.

- Received **42 Carrying Concealed Weapon Program referrals** from area courts.

- Assisted **Maingate Business Dev. and Gtr. Collinwood Dev. Corps.** with neighborhood cleanups.
